CAPC Parent Ed Contract –

 - Finalized scope – One Parent Ed sponsored specifically by CAPIT. Laura Valdez Chavez certified in two parent education curriculums that are through First 5. Start September 1st.
 - Primarily Spanish, South County, using Positive Discipline – Circle of Security – How to Raise Emotional Healthy Children.

Intimate Partner Violence -Laura Neal (lead discussion)

Early prevention strategies

- Knowledge gaps – campaign about IPV
- Information gathering expedition – which agencies/organizations involved
- Goal to fill gaps by increasing awareness

Coalition regarding Childhood – tabled

- Not clear on what this actually means

Staff Shortage- Julie Altman

- Lack of professional consistent workforce
- FCS – working on recruitment and retention efforts
- Overfill - Granted permission to hire positions beyond the numbers of allocated positions
- Not a specific item for CAPC

ACES(PACES)-

- Parent Ed contract stated they had to train to ACES (vague language)
- Help parents/parents to be understand the impacts of healthy development of an attachment and relationship with their child, help prevent the escalation of situation that ultimately leads to child abuse
- Parent Ed to include discussions about positive attachments and parenting
- Consider getting another trainer or reach out to community organizations that already have aspects of this curriculum for broader reach of those prevention efforts
- Connect and talk more in the frame of ACES
